9:30 – 10:45 a.m. – Workshop 1 – From Bum Diddy to Rock-n-Roll

a workshop for strumming/picking hand technique. Participants work on accuracy of picking individual strings and strumming/picking out a number of rhythms outside the norm for mountain dulcimers.

11:00 – 12:15 a.m. – Workshop 2 – Playing Upside Down

a workshop on playing inverted chords in DAd. The workshop will focus on building proficiency in playing out of inverted chords through skill-building exercises and learning songs which emphasize the technique.

1:30 – 2:45 p.m. – Workshop 3 -- Appalachian Mountain Songs for Beginners

A repertoire workshop featuring a varied collection. Includes of a couple “sad, lost love” songs; a rollicking, “foot stomper;” and a favorite Appalachian hymn.

3:00 – 4:15 p.m. – Celtic Harp Tunes

beautiful, lilting melodies from Celtic lands that really sound good on a dulcimer, including “Fairy Dance,” “Blind Mary,” and others.

5:00 p.m. - Concert
