Workshop Description: A repertoire workshop of songs from the great, blind bard of Ireland beautifully arranged for the mountain dulcimer. One of Joe's favorite Irish/classical composers, Turlough O'Carolan was a harpist at the end of the 17th into the early 18th century. Although he never wrote down any of his music, over 200 tunes have survived and are played all over the world today. These tunes are especially beautiful on the mountain dulcimer. Songs include "Fanny Power," "Beauty in Tears," and "Morgan Meaghan."

Level: Designed for intermediate players and above.

GOAL of the Workshop: Participants will use good chording technique to play some well-loved tunes by O'Carolan.
